



FALCON'S EYRIE

at Veritas Preparatory Academy (*grades 6-12*)

Falcon's Eyerie (formerly Homework Club) is a place for your Veritas Prep student to complete homework, receive peer tutoring, and quietly socialize with friends in a structured and supervised environment. When school is in session, the program runs every Monday/Tuesday and Thursday/Friday from 3:15 PM after school until 5:30 PM, excluding half-days and the last day of each semester.

Cost: (Until 5:30PM)

\$100/month for one child

\$70/month for each additional sibling

\$150/season for each student athlete

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

- Falcon's Eyrie is open to students in grades 6 – 12. It operates Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday (***excluding half-days and the last day of each semester***) from just after school until 5:30 PM.
- Please note that Falcon's Eyrie is a separate program from After-School Athenaeum (grades K – 5). **We are sorry, but "multiple child discounts" cannot be applied across the two programs.**
- Once you register and receive confirmation from the Director (in the form of a "Welcome Email"), you may begin sending your child to the program.
- Upon dismissal at the end of the day, students will have about 30 minutes to gather their belongings, have a snack, and proceed to the Falcon's Eyrie rooms, where they will sign in.
- If students have extracurriculars or need to attend tutoring with a teacher directly after school (prior to the start of Falcon's Eyrie, they may sign into Falcon's Eyrie once they are finished.
- If students have tutoring, extracurriculars, or other school obligations during the hours of Falcon's Eyrie, they may sign out to attend to them, and then return to Falcon's Eyrie.
- Parents do not need to communicate to us which days their children will attend; parents are responsible for instructing their children which days they should attend Falcon's Eyrie, and which days they will be picked up.
- We do not assume responsibility for registered students unless and until they actually sign into Falcon's Eyrie. Once they sign in, we will be responsible for them until parents pick them up and sign them out, or until they are dismissed for athletic practice.

WHAT is Falcon's Eyrie IS. . .AND IS NOT

Falcon's Eyrie is a safe, structured environment in which students may quietly work on homework until their parents arrive to pick them up or until they are dismissed for athletic practice. While we allow for quiet peer tutoring, it should be noted that **Falcon's Eyrie is not a "tutoring service."** Falcon's Eyrie monitors will be happy to answer the occasional question, but they will not be able to work individually with students for extended periods. Students who require individual tutoring should make arrangements with their teachers, or they may take advantage of the peer tutoring option.

Falcon's Eyrie monitors assume that students will work independently on their homework, and that, once their homework is finished, they will read, work ahead, play some of the quiet games we provide, etc. Monitors will not be checking to see that each student has finished his/her homework; completing homework is each student's responsibility.

PAYMENT POLICIES

- The "Student-Athlete" option applies only to students participating on a Veritas team. The cost is \$150 per season per child. Following the conclusion of the season, the student must be re-registered under the standard registration option.
- Each additional sibling after the first may be registered under the sibling rate of \$70.
- For monthly options, your first payment will be for a full month's cost, regardless of when you join, and will not be prorated.
- Monthly fee is payable on a monthly basis through recurring, automatic charge to your credit card on the first of each month.
- A charge of \$1.00/minute will be incurred for late pickups (after 5:30 PM). Monthly options may withdraw from the program with no penalty if you notify our office in writing by the **25th of the month prior** to the month you desire to withdraw. **Non-attendance is NOT a form of withdrawal.** You may rejoin at any time without re-paying the registration fee.
- Please note that, for monthly options, **no refunds** will be granted for withdrawals requested after the 25th of any month for the following month.
- Please note that partially used months **will not be prorated.**
- At this time, we regret that we cannot accept checks.
