By 8th grade, most students and families have determined methods of material organization that work well. However, the 8th grade team requires a durable, spiral bound, 3-hole punched notebook for each class, aside from the fine arts. Latin and Math both recommend this notebook be a 3-subject notebook. These spiral bound notebooks may be used up throughout the year and need to be replaced. Additionally, the 8th grade team recommends folders dedicated to one or two courses to organize any handouts received in class.
